Reflection:

Reflection:

Just before the school year started, just after finding out that I would be working as a part-time ITS, I also found out that our ITS was leaving our school to accept a position with the district office to support teachers across the county with their use of technology. This meant that I suddenly found myself in the position of learning with our new ITS (who had never held the position before), instead of from my mentor. On the other hand, it meant that I had to take a much bigger role in the training sessions than I would have done previously, as the new ITS does not know anything about itslearning, having held the position of Graduation Coach for the past year, and Media Specialist for at least the previous 7 years. Luckily, our former ITS (my mentor) has agreed to continue working with us to design and deliver training sessions with me during the periods that I am teaching. This will help to make the sessions run more smoothly, and will possibly help to smooth the transition as well.
